

## **Cookies**

Cookies are placed on the user's computer by the websites visited and contain information such as the page settings or login status.

Cookies are therefore small files created by the websites you visit. By saving browsing data, they improve the user experience. Cookies enable the website to remember your settings and offer locally relevant content.

The service provider's website sends a small file (cookie) to the computers of visitors to the website in order to determine the fact and time of the visit. The service provider informs visitors to the website of this.

The data subjects are visitors to the website.

The purpose of data processing is to provide additional services, identification, and visitor tracking.

Legal basis for data processing. The user's consent is not required if the use of cookies is absolutely necessary for the service provider.

Scope of data: unique identification number, time, configuration data.

The user has the option to delete cookies from their browser at any time in the Settings menu.

Data controllers entitled to access the data. The data controller does not process personal data through the use of cookies.

Data storage method: electronic.

## **Social media**

Social media is a media tool where messages are disseminated through social media users. Social media uses the internet and online publishing opportunities to enable users to become content editors rather than content consumers.

Social media is an interface of internet applications that contains content created by users, such as Facebook, Google+, Twitter, etc.

Forms of social media appearances can include public speeches, presentations, demonstrations, and product or service descriptions.

Information published on social media may take the form of forums, blog posts, images, videos, audio files, message boards, e-mail messages, etc.

In accordance with the above, the scope of data processed may include, in addition to personal data, the user's public profile picture.

Data subjects: all registered users.

The purpose of data collection is to promote the website or related web pages.

The legal basis for data processing is the voluntary consent of the data subject.

Duration of data processing: in accordance with the regulations available on the given social media site.

Data deletion deadline: as specified in the regulations available on the given social media site.

Those entitled to access the data: as specified in the regulations available on the given social media site.

Rights related to data processing: as specified in the regulations available on the given social media site.

Data storage method: electronic.

It is important to note that when the user uploads or submits any It is important to note that when a user uploads or submits any personal data, they grant the social media site operator worldwide permission to store and use such content. Therefore, it is very important to ensure that the user has full authority to disclose the published information.

## **Google Analytics**

In the case of Google Analytics:

Google Analytics compiles reports for its clients based on internal cookies about the habits of website users.

On behalf of the website operator, Google uses this information to evaluate how users use the website. As an additional service, it prepares reports on website activity for the website operator so that it can provide further services.

The data is stored in encrypted form on Google's servers to make it difficult and prevent misuse of the data.

Google Analytics can be disabled as follows. Quote from the page:

Website users who do not want Google Analytics JavaScript to report their data can install the Google Analytics opt-out browser add-on. The add-on prevents Google Analytics JavaScript ([ga.js](#), [analytics.js](#), and [dc.js](#)) from sending information to Google Analytics.

The browser add-on is available for most modern browsers. The Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add-on does not prevent data from being sent to the website itself and other web analytics services.

## **Rights related to data processing**

### Right to request information

You may request information from us via the contact details provided about what data our company processes, on what legal basis, for what data processing purposes, from what source, and for how long. At your request, we will send you information immediately, but no later than 30 days, to the email address you provided.

### Right to rectification

You can request us to modify any of your data via the contact details provided.

We will respond to your request immediately, but within a maximum of 30 days, and will send you information to the email address you provided.

### Right to erasure

You may request that we erase your data via the contact details provided. We will comply with your request immediately, but within 30 days at the latest, and will send you a notification to the email address you provided.

### Right to restriction of processing

You can request us to block your data via the contact details provided. The blocking will remain in place for as long as the reason specified by you requires the data to be stored. At your request, we will do so immediately, but within a maximum of 30 days, and we will send you information to the email address you provided.

### Right to object

You may object to the processing of your data via the contact details provided.

We will examine your objection as soon as possible after receiving your request, but within a maximum of 15 days, decide on its validity, and inform you of our decision by email.

### Enforcement options related to data processing

If you experience unlawful data processing, please notify our company so that the lawful status can be restored within a short period of time. We will do everything in your interest to resolve the problem outlined.
